\*Genesis 15:16 Faith was credited as righteousness

-This long journey, based on faith planted the foundational concept that man's relationship with God is based on faith. For without faith it is impossible to please God (Hebrews 11:6). The faith principle is imbedded in man's walk with God-- from beginning to end. God spoke of it also through the prophet Habakkuk (Hab. 2:4) saying "The righteous will live by faith."
