 - 2. Or to be free of some physical dilemma
 - 3. To escape the encumbrances of the flesh
 - * While all these things will certainly be part of heaven....
 - -If they stand as our motivation we are sadly missing the point.
 - -Because our motivation for heaven should be one single thing:
 - * An over-whelming desire to simply be in the presence of God.
 - * That is what heaven is about
