 - -Gethsemane olive press
 - -squeezing
 - -John 6:38 "For I have come down out of heaven to do the will of the one who sent me.
- IV. Can we know what God's will is? ANSWER!
 - * The answer is yesread Romans 12:1-2
 - -What please God
 - -Reading the bible and we find out.
 - -Meditating on is day and night.
