Introduction:

In Ezekiel chapter 37:1-14 we read about the valley of dry bones. Ezekiel was a prophet of Judah right before Babylon carried them away to captivity and he was also a prophet during captivity.

READ EZEKIEL 37:1-14

- -Spiritual drought
- -Not what God had wanted them to be
- -He raised the Babylonians up to discipline Israel

-Heb 12:6

*Hope in being made healthy again

*Prayer is a vital part of our relationship with God.

*If your struggling this morning there is hope

-In a relationship with God

-We find hope in prayer.

Lesson:

I. The presence of God is awesome

-Read Ex. 19:16-19

-In the presence of God we have seen:

- -The heavens created
- -The Sea parted
- -Time stand still

-Time go backwards

- -Pillars of cloud and fire
- -Smoke above the tabernacle
- *In the presence of God we have seen the greatest love this world Has ever known in his son Jesus.

*The mere mention of being in the presence of God makes me excited.

II. Moses

- -Raised in the house of pharaoh as an Egyptian Ex. Ch 2
- -Found his heritage and went to Midian
- -Married Zapporah and had kids
- -Shepparding his father in laws (Jethro's) flocks
 - *Sees a burning bush
 - *READ Exodus 3:1-5

*TAKE OFF SANDLES FOR YOUR STANDING ON HOLY GROUND.

- III. When we cross into the NT we realize that we too have a burning bush experience through prayer.
 - -Its really no less miraculous than what Moses experienced
 - -Just like in the worship right now
 - -(God is here in our midst) Matt 18:20
 - -You are in the presence of God right now
 - -I don't know about you but there is no place I would rather be.
 - -How much more when we pray do we approach the very throne of God Heb 4:16
- IV. When we go to God's presence in prayer I think there is a NT concept we must remember.
 - -READ MATT 5:23-24
 - *Reason for removing the sandles is perhaps that God doesn't want anything separating you and him.
 - *I have seen many Christians over my life sit in the pews and try to honor God with bitterness, anger, and hostility in their hearts.
 - -In Matt 27 we see the seen of the cross
 - -3 groups of people their
 - -Those at the back.....Not engaged
 - -Ecclesastical.....Legal hard liners
 - -Those at the foot of the cross
 - -Here enemies become friends with Jesus closely in view.
 - *I think recently we have pointed out that our relationships are important to God and he places priority on them.
- V. We too are called to be Holy 1 Peter 1:15
 - -Set apart from the world
 - -God wants us their before him
 - *But with clean hearts

- VI. I want to remind you that we can do things that will hinder our prayers.
 - -Read Psalms 66:18
 - -Read 1 Peter 3:7
