## Psams 23

## Psalm of David

- I. 1a "The LORD is my shepherd,..."
  - A. In one of the most well know psalms, in Psalms 23 David stopped and considered his life before the God.
    - 1. He realizes that in the same way he had cared for his sheep...that God had cared for him.
  - B. He knows that God has watched over his paths
  - C. That God has guided his steps away from danger and pitfalls
  - D. And time and time again God has protected him
  - E. In short David knew God cared for him deeply
  - \* David humbly submitted to God's leadership in his life.

## II. 1b "I shall not want."

- A. David realized that God would provide for him
- B. And that all his needs would be meet.
  - 1. David figured that if he didn't have it ....God must not want him to.
- C. So by faith David walked this old earth knowing that God would take care of him.
- D. David, realized that God would determine and meet his needs.
- **III.** 2 "He makes me lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside quiet waters."
  - A. David saw many storms in life, but he knew who he had believed in and he turned to Him for peace.
  - B. Peace in God is very precious
    - 1. This kind of peace is that which surpasses understanding ... Phil 4:7
    - 2. And ultimately entering the peace of God by leaving this world...Isa 57:2

## IV. 3a "He restores my soul;"

- A. Sometimes souls can get out of line with God's desires.
- B. Through bad choices and even circumstances of life.

- 1. We can all struggle at times with God.
- C. But like a loving father, God stands ready to receive us back unto Himself and make our hearts new again.
  - 1. Luke 15
  - 2. Psalms 51
- V. 3b "He guides me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake."
  - A. God guides us
  - B. He gives us direction
    - 1. With His word as a lamp unto our feet...Psalms 119:105
    - 2. And even the promptings of our hearts.
  - C. Jeremiah 10:23 "I know, O LORD, that a man's way is not in himself, Nor is it in a man who walks to direct his steps."
- **VI. 4** *"Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil, for You are with me;"* 
  - A. God is with us
    - 1. He never leaves us
  - B. When we walk through life's troubles...we don't walk alone
  - C. There is nothing to fear
  - D. Even when we can't see
    - 1. Like the poem "Footprints in the sand"
- VII. 4b "Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me."
  - A. Life often gives us much anxiety
  - B. When we walk with the Lord what comfort surrounds us.

VIII. 5a "You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies;"

A. God gives us **<u>victory</u>** 

- 1. Even when we can't see it
- 2. 2 Kings 6:16-17 "So he answered, "Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them." 17 Then Elisha prayed and said, "O LORD, I pray, open his eyes that he may see." And the LORD opened the servant's eyes and he saw; and behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha."
- IX. 5b "You have anointed my head with oil;"
  - A. Anointing here has to do with setting apart and establishing.
  - B. The word that comes to mind is **purpose**
- **X. 5c** "My cup overflows."
  - A. Here we are talking about **provision** 
    - 1. Everything pertaining to life and godliness ...2 Peter 1:3
    - 2. A good measure pressed down and overflowing....Luke 6:38
- XI. 6 "Surely goodness and lovingkindness will follow me all the days of my life, And I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever."
  - A. A promise claimed by faithful obedience to God.
  - B. To dwell in the house of the Lord forever.
